Environment Capability Statement

Environmental Management Systems – development and implementation.

We have developed and implemented fully documented Environmental Management Systems and Management Plans covering energy, water and waste. These have been provided to a range of client organisations including those in the resources, healthcare, government and tertiary education sectors. Our systems conform to national and international standards for environmental management and legislative and regulatory approvals requirements.

Compliance, Risk, Reporting and Strategy for Environmental and Carbon Pollution Legislation

We provide support services to organisations for internal & external environmental management systems, their compliance audit risk assessment, monitoring and reporting obligations under federal, state and local government legislation and regulatory requirements. This includes site audits, data collection and assessment, checks on accuracy and integrity of data etc. Sectors covered to date include resources, utilities, healthcare and education, commercial, industrial, port, marine and transport.

“Whole of Life” measures of environmental impact for products, services and operations

We provide life cycle environmental impact/footprint assessments on products, services, facilities and organisations. These include life cycle assessments to international standards for carbon footprint and ecological footprint.

National Pollutant Inventory (NPI) reporting

We provide assistance with NPI reporting by identifying substances emitted, thresholds exceeded and substance categorisation. This process is enhanced by use of a specialised NPI tool, developed by Alberfield, to perform relevant calculations and output a “report” which may be directly transcribed into the NPI Report page. The tool simplifies reporting, minimises compliance costs and builds internal capacity reducing the need for external consultant assistance.

GBCA Accredited Professional

We provide the services of a Green Building Council of Australia Green Star Accredited Professional. GBCA points may be obtained by employing the services of an Accredited Professional on the planning team and during the construction phase. The Professional's experience may be employed in maximising the Energy Efficiency of any building notwithstanding the requirement for formal accreditation.
